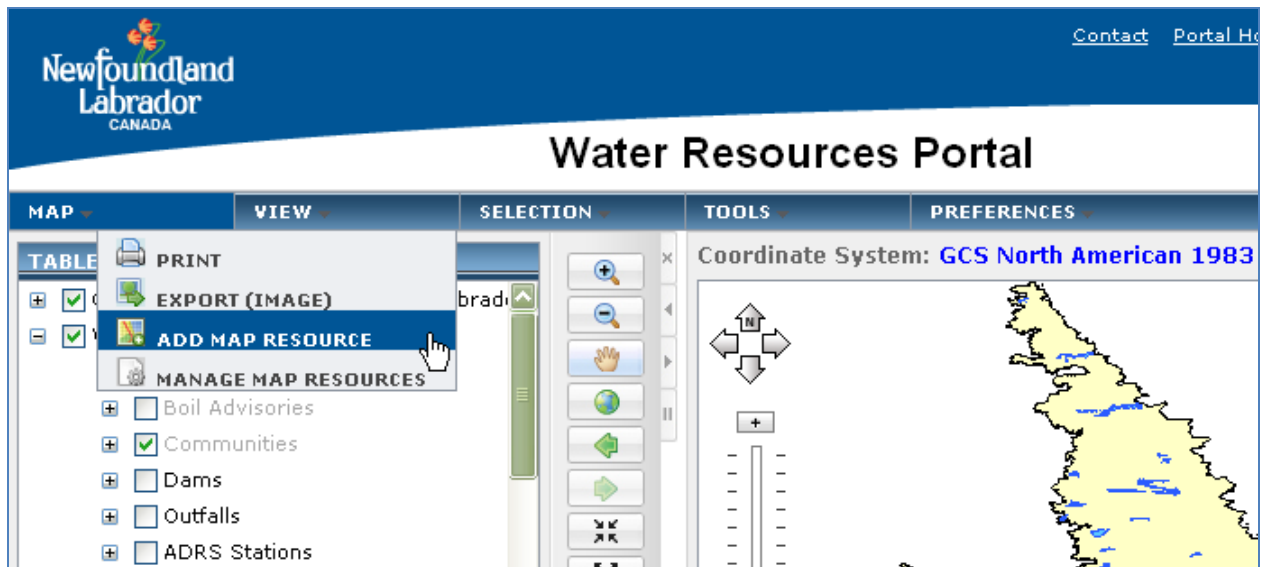


Adding a WMS Service to the Water Resources Portal

On the Map Menu, choose Add Map Resource




In the window that opens, choose OGC (WMS) Service from the Type dropdown list.

Then click the Get Services button. The available services will be listed under Services.
